

'Cookies' policy

Introduction

This policy describes the cookies and other technologies used on this website.

For more information on the processing of personal data and on exercising your rights, please consult the <u>Personal data processing policy</u> published on the site.

1. Definition of cookies

Cookies are small data files that are downloaded to your device by the website you visit. By using cookies and similar technologies (together referred to as 'cookies'), websites can record information about visitors. This information may include your IP address, the device you are using and your click behaviour, such as the specific web pages you visit and how you navigate the website.

2. Different types of cookies

There are different types of cookies, such as 'session cookies', which expire when you close your web browser, and 'persistent cookies', which remain on your computer or mobile device until you delete them. Some cookies are set by the website operator ('first-party cookies'), while other cookies are set by third parties ('third-party cookies') and enable them to also collect information from your browser and devices.

Cookies can be classified in the following categories:

- Strictly necessary cookies Also known as 'essential cookies', these cookies are essential to enable you to browse the website and use its features. These cookies are generally first-party session cookies.
- Preference cookies Also known as 'functionality cookies', these cookies enable a website to remember choices you have made in the past, such as your preferred language.
- Statistical cookies Also known as 'analytical or performance cookies', these cookies collect information about how you use a website, such as the pages you have visited. This includes cookies from third party analysis services, provided that the cookies are for the exclusive use of the owner of the website visited.
- Marketing cookies These cookies track your online activity to help advertisers deliver more relevant advertising or to limit the number of times you see an advertisement. These cookies may share this information with other organisations or advertisers. These are persistent cookies and are generally third-party cookies.
